Please take responsibility for your own safety while you're with us, by adhering closely to all guidelines.

- While we continue to observe social distancing, there is a limited number of tickets available to this showing which can be bought in pairs or single seats only.
- Tickets must be bought in advance online, we are unable to sell tickets on the door. There is no need for you to print your online ticket.
- In order that we can operate a Track and Trace system should it be necessary, your details will be kept on file for 21 days after your visit.
- Try to travel off-peak or walk/cycle to the venue where possible
- Wearing a mask in the theatre is mandatory to ensure the safety of our performers
- Those of you who are familiar with the theatre will notice a few changes on entrance and exit, put in place to ensure optimum safety. Please follow signs and listen out for our specially trained Front Of House team who will guide you up to the space.
- You will see that seats are clearly numbered. Please move directly to your seat and remain seated until the interval or end of show when our Front Of House will guide you out of the theatre.
- We kindly ask that audience members do not shout or whoop at the end of a performance but instead show your appreciation through a good sturdy clap!
